#### COVID-19 & CBME Implementation Expectations

- CBME & COVID-19 Town Hall held on May 13<sup>th</sup> w/ latest guidance from Royal College. Takeaways included:
  - - Encouraged to reduce targets as necessary
  - Less data available to make promotion / progress decisions
    - Competence Committees have authority to Progress and Promote Residents and Fellows based on available data – if performance is otherwise acceptable – with expectation that 'missing' competencies are tracked for the duration of their training to ensure completion
  - Adjustments to Residency Program's education / assessment plan requirements may be necessary
  - Changes to education & assessment plans, CC decisions and data used to inform them <u>must be documented</u>

#### **Prep for 2020-21**

- Prioritizing EPA tool building for newly launching CBD programs
- Deferred programs offered opportunity to pilot
  - Aim for tools in mid-late July





### **Prep for 2020-21**

 Survey sent to <u>all</u> Programs re: changes to education & assessment delivery for 2019-20 & plans for 2020-21 (incl. faculty dev't needs)

- CBD Faculty & Resident Development Planning
  - Faculty development ongoing, May+
  - Resident orientations July
  - PD & PA Elentra Training ongoing
  - Communications & training relating to dev't changes in Elentra (e.g. Assessment Plan, EPA expiry, etc.)





## Planned (minor) Refinements to Entrustment Scale for 2020-21

- In follow-up to:
  - Survey consultation with Faculty and Learners from CBD launched programs
  - Review of the literature on postgraduate programs that have used entrustment assessments





## Planned (minor) Refinements to Entrustment Scale

- Plan for refinements:
  - BPEA tasked with refining EPA scale for 2020, in consideration of:
    - What is feasible to implement in Elentra at this time
    - Consistent with the feedback received from stakeholder groups
    - The need to alert and train up Faculty and Learners regarding any changes
  - Group to convene over next few weeks
