Types of Rotations

- Standard
 - One rotation at one location
- Multi-Site
 - One rotation at multiple hospitals/sites
- Longitudinal
 - One rotation at one location, not every day

Why Enter Trainee Rotations In POWER?

Evaluations

Preceptor Payment

MOH funding rendered to preceptors training UofT Residents on their clinical rotations, in UofT community affiliated hospitals or physician offices.

Medical Tracking Days (MTDs)

MOH funding rendered to Ontario hospitals for medical learners' rotating through their site.

On-Call Stipends

Funding rendered to UofT Residents for on-call work conducted at affiliated hospitals.

Preceptor Payment

Conditions:

- Preceptor must be UofT faculty appointed
- Learner must be UofT Resident
- Rotation must be eligible
- Hospital/Site must be eligible
