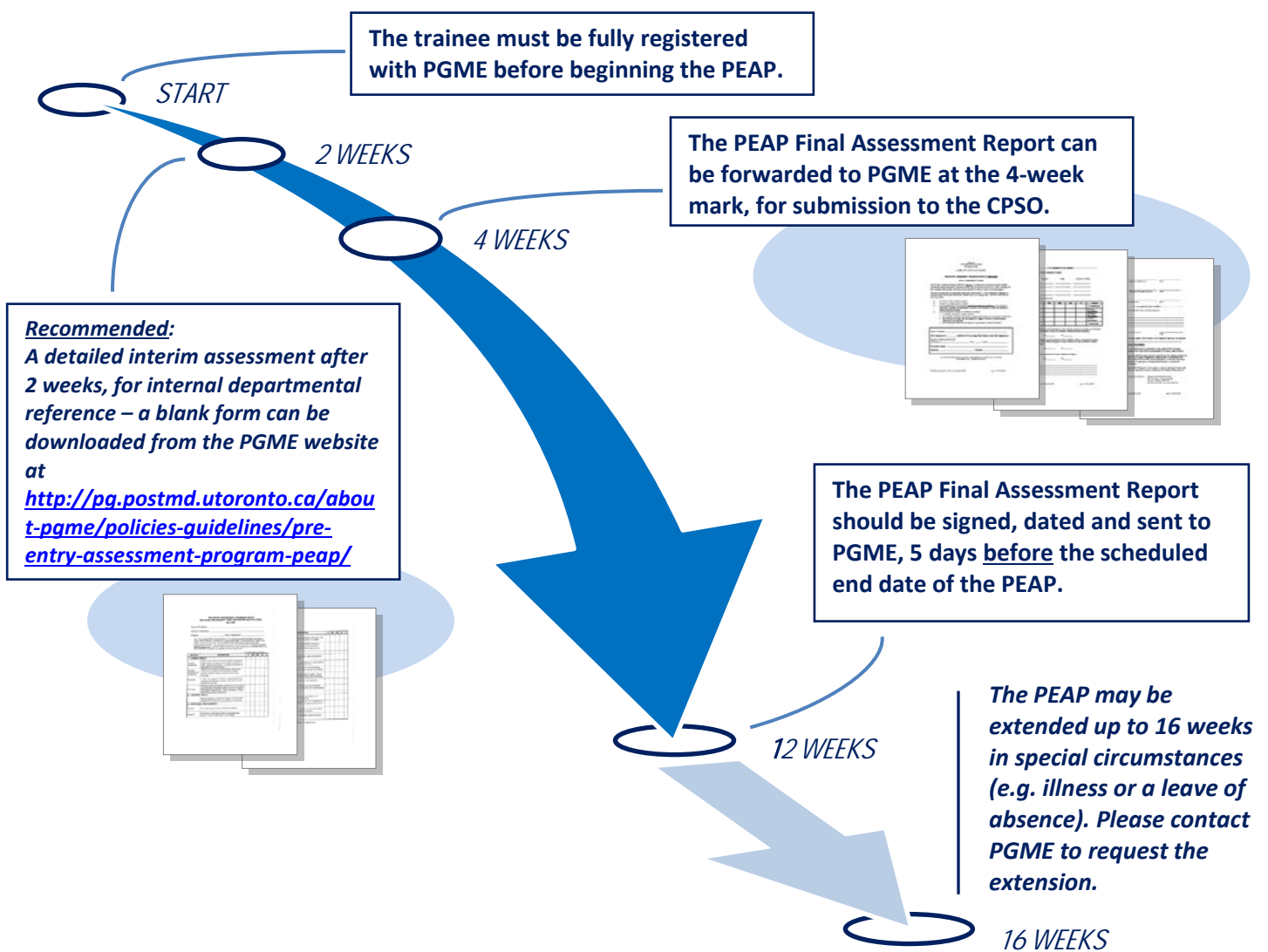


Pre-Entry Assessment Program (PEAP)

Timeline Overview

- The PEAP is mandatory for international medical graduates (IMGs) entering residency training outside the CaRMS match process, for IMGs entering clinical fellowship training or for IMGs entering elective residency (if the elective IMG's home residency program is outside Canada and the US).
- For clinical fellows (and residents), the PEAP must be at least 4 weeks, and no more than 12 weeks, in duration. The PEAP can be extended to 16 weeks in special circumstances, such as illness, a leave of absence or supervisor unavailability. Please contact PGME in Advance to discuss potential extension requests.
